As Head of Climate Science and International Evidence within DECC David Warrilow ensures the UK Government receives sound scientific advice on climate change. He leads the UK's delegation to the IPCC (Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change) and is a member of the UK delegations to the UNFCCC (UN Framework Convention on Climate Change).

David will review how the UK and the world as a whole are trying to address the challenges of climate change and how vital it is that policy is informed by the latest scientific evidence.

He'll consider the role of the IPCC in providing key scientific input to international climate negotiations and will comment on recent calls for reform of the IPCC. David will also discuss the role of science during the next round of negotiations in Cancun, Mexico at the beginning of December.
